Efforts taken by Institution to enhance the capabilities of students for both speaking and writing in Simple Standard Sanskrit fluently, correctly and naturally. Developing all four skills of Sanskrit language is always a driving point of the campuses to train up the students especially, speaking and writing skills and their usage in Simple Standard Sanskrit language.

After the admission process is completed, the campus conducts

- a ten day <u>Sanskrit Sambhashana Shibiram</u> for students of all classes and courses to learn the alphabets of Devanagari script to practice writing skills and to learn speaking skills in a Simple Standard Sanskrit language.
- The base laid down here will help students immensely in the longer run of their stint in the campus in obtaining UG and PG degrees.

The University conducts <u>All India Elocution Competition</u> every year at a Campus selected for the purpose.

- The students of the campus compete against the students of other institutions of the State Government, in which the said campus is located.
- The best competitors are selected to represent the campus in the all India Competition.
- Students from other Sanskrit Universities also compete and the best students will win prizes and gold medals.
- Events like Vakyartha, Shalaka, Shastrartha and elocution etc., provide the students an opportunity to display their oratorical skills in simple Standard Sanskrit way.

The Inter Campus **Youth Festival** is organized annually is another great opportunity for the students. It tests the skills of students in Academic events like

• Recitation,

- Debate, and
- Quiz etc.
- Cultural events mono-act play,
- Sanskrit skit,
- Classical song,
- folk song and
- a short drama etc., also test the students of their simple standard Sanskrit skills.

The <u>all India Inter Campus Drama Festival</u> previously called Kaumudi Mahotsav is conducted for the students of all campuses every year.

- The University allots a theme or a shortened version of a Sanskrit Drama to each Campus and the Festival runs for three days.
- It is the best platform for the university students to exhibit their histrionic along with their proficiency in simple standard Sanskrit skills.

<u>Sanskrit Week festival</u> is celebrated on the eve of Shravana Poornima in all campuses and in Head Quarters office as well. So many competitions like

- recitation
- writing essay and
- debate, etc., are conducted basing on the Sanskrit related topics and the students are encouraged to participate in large numbers to show off their simple standard Sanskrit skills.
- Vakyarthasabha or Vagvardhini is observed in all campuses to provide a competitive platform to the students to display their oratorical and simple standard speaking skills in Sanskrit.

<u>Assignments</u> are given to students and after correction; the teacher gives suggestions for each and every student how to improve the simple standard language skills in Sanskrit.

• The students are encouraged to participate in literary games to improve their vocabulary.

- The students are taught in simple standard Sanskrit language.
- They are also taught how to write in simple standard Sanskrit so that they can write answers in their examinations in a simple standard Sanskrit.
