Details of the programme for the exchange/participation of students at national/international level for academic and cultural activities with other institutions.

The University allows its students from all campuses to participate in various literary, cultural and games and sports events organized by other Sanskrit Universities like

- National Sanskrit University, Tirupati and
- some private organizations like Glory Fest, Puri etc.
- The University also mooted to implement the direction of the MHRD, Government of India for the programme, “Ek Bharat, Shrestha Bharat” received in November, 2019 in which 50 students will embark on a cultural tour to another institution under the policy of Cultural Exchange.
- The University has directed each and every campus to have a tie up with the Institutions located in different states as suggested in the Annexure enclosed with the University’s letter.
- The programme has remained a non-starter due to the quick fire spread of perilous pandemic Covid-19.
- However, under the programme the campus has to pair itself with a university or institution of the State, as suggested in the annexure enclosed with the letter.
- Various programmes are suggested to be held during the period of holidays and vacations only. The salient features of the programme of “Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat are:
- 50 students to move from the Campus to an institution in paired state for five days interaction/cultural exchange/local visits/institutions etc. This would be followed by similar move by chosen institution to its paired campus.
- Youth Festival is to be held in the paired institution of the suggested State and the paired campus of the University.
- Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat Day will be observed with focus on the programmes like cultural, language and food exchange etc in the paired campus and chosen institution.
- EBSB Clubs can be formed to meet at least once in a month.
- Screening of films can be done by EBSB Clubs.
- The campuses are directed to submit monthly reports to the MHRD through the University.

Moreover, the campuses of the University are located in significant places situated in various states of East, West, North, South and North-East etc. They reflect the multi cultured nature of the University.

- Hence the organization of Youth Festival, Drama Festival and All India Elocution etc allows the students to know one another very well in their regional habits and practices etc.
- These annual programmes are so popular with their diversity, they become instant hits with not only among the students but also among the public.
- Thus, this University is almost like a mini India with all diversities reflected through its campuses.
