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Support mechanism and initiatives taken out by the Institution for preparing the students to participate, succeed in reputed examination and in-depth shastra knowledge/ avadhana/shastrartha to the students and encouraging them to take various shastra exams conducted by different organizations in addition to regular teaching.

First and foremost priority is to train the students to learn to speak Sanskrit with correct accent.

- For this, Simple Standard Sanskrit programmes are arranged in all campuses for the students of all classes and courses.
- The students not only learn speaking language skills but also learn the writing language skills of Sanskrit as some of the students come from general or modern background and Devanagari script is new for them.
- The inputs and materials of Simple Standard Sanskrit are used for the benefit of the students.

Another programme called Vag Vardhini, to increase proficiency in the language skills of Sanskrit, is conducted in all campuses.

- It is a part of time table of all the classes. This is conducted once in a week.
- In this academic programme the students are encouraged to interact and to participate in the analytical and oratorical activities.
- They can debate and argue taking any one side of the topic.
- It drives away their fear or phobia of the stage or taking part in the group discussions.

- Annual Function provide them ample opportunities to display their capabilities.

Various academic competitions like

All India Intercampus Youth Festival and All India Intercampus Drama Festival also provide them with a good platform to propel themselves into regional and national limelight.

Besides, they get in-depth shastric knowledge from the learned teachers which moulds them to become future scholars to impart training to their students.

- If a scholar passes in all examinations, he/she will get a cash award of Rs 2 lakh.
- Final Examination/Oral test is conducted by Kanchi Peethadheeshwarji.
- Ahmadnagar Pareeksha is also famous for conducting examinations in 15 traditional subjects.
- Final test is conducted by Sringeri Peethadheeshwarji.
