Incremental improvements made during the preceding five years (in case of first cycle)

Answer -

The institution has recorded many improvements during the five years post accreditation by taking up the quality initiatives as suggested.

As the nodal agency of the Ministry of Education, Government of India, it executes various central schemes including Astadashi research projects, Adarsh scheme under which some 26 institutions including four Sodh Sansthans, have been receiving grant and other schemes like Pali and Prakrit etc. in addition so many institutes are affiliated to this university in significant places across India.

All the departments are provided with a computer system and a printer along with uninterrupted high speed internet connectivity to provide qualitative teaching and to organize webinars and online classes and meetings etc.

- This mode of online classes has come in handy during the time of Covid-19.
- So the students and teachers are well connected virtually for teaching and interacting purpose.
- The teachers are encouraged to participate in webinars and in online classes and also to improve their potentiality in the field of research.
- Even Sanskrit Sambhashana shibirams are organized in online mode during the time of pandemic.

The teachers are always helpful in providing study materials like notes etc to students.

- They are also engaged in conducting free coaching classes for students to prepare for NET/SLET and other competitive examinations etc.

- IQAC has been on its mission constantly monitoring the provision of quality education to students.
- Research books and magazines are published as students and teachers are highly motivated in research activities.

Under Career Advancement Scheme of the UGC eligible teachers are promoted to next higher grade or promotion. This kind of activity will certainly boost up the energy of the teachers and make them more motivated and dedicated to students and to institution, as well.

- National, international seminars are organized to explore various areas of research and application.
- These seminars are conducted both in online and offline modes.

New courses like Diploma

- in vastu,
- Jyotisha,
- Yoga and
- Ayurveda Literature, etc., are started in campuses like Jaipur, Bhopal and Guruvayoor.
- They are started under self financing scheme.
- Similarly, a course in Natya Shastra is started in Bhopal Campus, to explore into the nuances of classical dance forms.
- NSS wing is started in campuses where it hasn't been in vogue previously.
- It will provide the students the realistic situation of the village or town where the camps are organized.
- It adds pragmatic approach to the multi dimensions of development of the students.
- It also leads them to know and realize the ground reality.

Steps are taken to improve the library facility in campus to get updated to the latest technology.

- The software is upgraded. 24X7 internet facility is made available.
- Initiative steps are taken to adapt open access system. E-Journals, E-Magazines and e-Books are subscribed.

- Special books of reference are taken into the digitalization process.
- Plans are mulled to make the library accessible to students and staff for extra hours of time extending the library timings beyond 5 pm.
