NOTIFICATION FOR ENGAGEMENT OF FULL TIME FACULTY ON CONTRACTUAL BASIS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INDIAN JURISPRUDENCE, CENTRAL SANSKRIT UNIVERSITY, JAIPUR CAMPUS, IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE BAR COUNCIL OF INDIA RULES OF LEGAL EDUCATION, 2008

The Central Sanskrit University is inviting online applications from eligible Indian nationals for engagement of Full-Time Faculty on contractual basis in the Department of Indian Jurisprudence, Jaipur Campus, Jaipur in compliance with the Bar Council of India rules of legal education, 2008.

The engagement shall be purely temporary and contractual for a fixed period and shall not confer any right to regular appointment in the University. Interested candidates possessing the requisite qualifications and fulfilling the prescribed eligibility criteria may apply through online mode only as per the prescribed guidelines. Eligible candidates shortlisted on the basis of their applications shall be required to appear for the Online Interview.

2. The candidates shall be informed accordingly through their registered email only. Hence, candidates are advised to check their email, including the SPAM folder, regularly.
3. The Central Sanskrit University reserves the right to reject any application without assigning any reason thereof. The University also reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of vacancies/positions as per requirement and circumstances.
4. In case any candidate fails to appear for the Test and/or Interview due to any reason, problem or incidental cause whatsoever, the University shall not be responsible for the same.
5. If any controversy arises in the selection process or if any candidate has dissatisfaction regarding the process, the decision of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, CSU shall be final and binding.
